Call for Application: Postdoctoral research fellowship

The Rector of Pavol Jozef Šafárik University in Košice announces a call for application for

postdoctoral research positions at P. J. Šafárik University in Košice.

Eligibility criteria for a candidate:

A graduate of the third level of higher education in one of the following fields of study:

Additional criteria and requirements:

- authorship or co-authorship of at least 2 research papers published in journals registered in professional databases (WoS, SCOPUS, ERIH) or other peer-reviewed works such as scientific monographs or peer-reviewed scientific journals;
- the eligible period of the candidate's completion of the third level of higher education is 1 to 5 years from the call's publishing date.

Required documents:

- professional curriculum vitae,
- certified copies of the second-and thirdlevel university diplomas
- an overview of the published papers registered in the WoS, SCOPUS, and ERIH professional databases, including citations; in case the outputs are not registered in the WoS, SCOPUS and ERIH, their copies or copies of the relevant pages indicating the applicant's authorship along with the relevant bibliographic information are required (title page, imprint, content, documentation of the review process, if the reviewers are not listed in the publication, etc.)
- list of research projects indicating the role of the candidate and list of study mobilities abroad,
- two letters of recommendation from two professors, while only one of the professors may work at the applicant's training workplace,
- letter of acceptance from a Professor (guarantor) of the third level education from the receiving institution listed in Appendix no. 1,
- project proposal to be realized at the host institution (maximum 2 pages),
- confirmation of previous work experience (listed from the latest)
- criminal record; to be only presented by the selected candidates.

The applicants are expected to submit the application and the required documents (attachments of the application) signed (application and project proposal) and scanned in a pdf format. Applications submitted after the deadline will not be taken into account.
