10:00 - 15:00 Qualitative research design and analysis

**Abstract:** The aim of this workshop is to provide an overview of the epistemological framework of qualitative research as well as the basic steps in designing and conducting a qualitative research project in the social sciences. Inter alia, attention will be given to issues of research problem and research question posing, recruitment, data collection, data analysis and research ethics. The workshop is addressed to novice qualitative researchers and workshop participants are encouraged to come to the workshop sharing questions and/or challenges they may be facing in their own experience with qualitative research.

10:00 - 15:00 Secondary data analysis across studies: An introduction to cross-study research

**Abstract:** This half-day pre-conference workshop will provide an insightful introduction to the methodology and techniques of secondary data analysis across studies, with a focus on longitudinal cohort study data. The workshop begins by outlining the conceptual underpinnings of cross-study research, highlighting its relevance in various disciplines including social sciences, healthcare, and education. Participants will be introduced to key concepts of data harmonisation, equivalence and standardisation and will explore the advantages and challenges of undertaking cross-study research. Through a combination of interactive lectures and hands-on exercises, participants will learn about practical strategies for navigating the intricacies of secondary data analysis across studies, as well as understanding the benefits of cross-study research for academic investigation.

10:00 - 15:00 On Writing Well

**Abstract:** This workshop will have two parts. In the morning we will discuss writing as praxis, think about who we are as writers and who we are writing for, formulate writing goals, and engage in writing exercises to practice clear, strong writing. Participants will be asked to bring something they are working on to practice a few writings and editing strategies. In the afternoon we will have a mini-writing retreat. We will dedicate a few hours of uninterrupted time to work independently, but in the presence of fellow workshop participants for support. Learning writing strategies, practicing, and developing a community of support are important for getting writing done and doing it well.

10:00 - 15:00 Introduction to Longitudinal Data Modelling with R

**Abstract:** Longitudinal data, or repeated measures, are often considered the gold standard for studying developmental processes in the behavioral sciences. In this workshop, we will focus on longitudinal analysis methods that answer two broad key developmental questions: how do things change over time, and what are the interrelationships in behavioral change. The workshop will use R, a freely available software to conduct statistical analysis, and will introduce the participants in statistical methods under the Structural Equation Modeling (SEM) framework, such as Latent Growth Curve Modeling and CrossLagged Panel Models

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10:00 - 15:00 Mixture Modeling for Cross-Sectional and Longitudinal Data: Latent Class/Profile Analysis and Growth Mixture Modeling/Latent ClassGrowth Analysis

Abstract: Are you interested in so-called 'person-centered' analyses? Do you have a research question

concerning unobserved (i.e., latent) subgroups of individuals within your sample that have similar characteristics and requires mixture modelling? For example, are you interested in subgroups with different profiles/scores on several variables, or subgroups with different developmental paterns on one or more variables over time? Would you like more information on the decisions (and potential challenges) involved in conducting mixture modeling and how to interpret the results of these analyses? Sign up for this pre-conference workshop and learn more about mixture modeling in the context of both crosssectional and longitudinal data! This pre-conference workshop will introduce you to the methodology and analysis of personcentered analyses and Mixture Modeling, using a combination of interactive lectures and small individual and group exercises. The Mplus software program will be used for illustrating and interpreting results (one part of the workshop), but NO specific background in this program is required!

The workshop will specifically address Latent Class/Profile Analysis, Growth Mixture Modeling, and Latent Class Growth Analysis.

#### 1. Planning Eco-Friendly Conferences: The Future of Scientific Meetings

Join the conversation to learn how to navigate these complex challenges and implement solutions that satisfy both open science principles and data protection regulations.
