The conference working languages are **Ukrainian**, **Polish and English**. Abstracts of the reports will be published in the conference proceedings. Deadline for abstracts is **September 10, 2024**. Participation at the conference is **free of charge**.

Requirements for abstracts:

1. The paper should have the following parts: UDK, title (in capital letters), names and surnames of the authors, full name of the institution, department, university, etc.

2. The text is printed on one side of a standard sheet of paper of format A4 with the interval -1,5 mm, (28-30 lines per page), font size -14, (total number of symbolms per page 1800-1900), no more than 2 pages. Document fields - 20 mm.

3. Proceedings are printed in the Microsoft Office Word editor in *.docx, *.doc or *.rtf format. Tables can be printed in the "Microsoft Office Word" editor, graphics - in "Microsoft Office Excel", formulas - in "MS Equation", drawings and graphic files with the extension *.jpeg. Send all these in separate files. The name of the file must correspond to the last name of the first author.

The abstracts electronic version in *.docx, *.doc or *.rtf format with the first author's last name, a cover letter from the institution (printed and scanned) with the signatures of the authors (except for employees of IFNMU) must be sent by September 10, 2024 to the e-mail: sciencemeeting@ifnmu.edu.ua

Abstracts that do not meet the requirements will not be considered!
