Requirements for successful completion of the course

Participation and attendance on seminars:

Students are required to participate in all lectures and seminars. Students have to actively participate during seminars, come prepared, and have thoroughly studied the material from the previous lecture.

Ongoing Evaluation:

Students will complete at least five small tests throughout the course. These tests will cover theoretical content from the corresponding lecture and exercises from the previous seminar (see <u>Content of lectures and seminars</u>). Students have to achieve at least 60 % in average from small tests.

Handling Absences:

In the case of excused absence seminars, student will prepare seminar work, present it as power point presentation (pptx, 3-5 min) or in written form (2-3 pages, Times New Roman, 1.5 line spacing, references). The supervisor will choose an appropriate topic.

Final Assessment:

The final evaluation will be given on the results of small tests and students activities on the seminars.
