### **Requirements for successful completion of the course**

#### **Participation and attendance on seminars:**

Students are required to participate in all lectures and seminars. Students have to actively participate during seminars, come prepared, and have thoroughly studied the material from the previous lecture.

#### **Ongoing Evaluation:**

Students will complete at least five small tests throughout the course. These tests will cover theoretical content from the corresponding lecture and exercises from the previous seminar (see [\*Content of lectures and seminars\*](#)). Students have to achieve at least 60 % in average from small tests.

#### **Handling Absences:**

In the case of excused absence seminars, student will prepare seminar work, present it as power point presentation (pptx, 3-5 min) or in written form (2-3 pages, Times New Roman, 1.5 line spacing, references). The supervisor will choose an appropriate topic.

#### **Final Assessment:**

The final evaluation will be given on the results of small tests and students activities on the seminars.
