1.,2.	<p>Summer Surgical Practice for the students finished 5th year of study General Medicine Timetable: Surgical Practice 2 weeks</p> <p>A / General principles:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The summer surgical practice is a continuation of the study of surgery in small groups of students at the surgical departments. 2. During practice, the goal is to have students acquire the basic practical methods of examination, diagnosis and treatment principles in surgery, with special emphasis on acute surgery particularly acute abdomen and injury, shock, resuscitation, rehabilitation and assessment activity. 3. During practice each medical student works in the operating rooms, outpatient and inpatient surgery. Students must stay for a minimum of 2 times during the emergency services. <p>B / The content and practice:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The content of the practice clinic: Outpatient practice of surgical training is the focus of professional practice. The aim is to gain practical experience outpatient examination and treatment of the patient especially during emergencies situations, accidents and primary treatment. The students assist in small outpatient procedures such as puncture, incision, excision and suturing wounds, repositioning simple fractures, carry out the treatment of wounds. They learn first-aid equipment, splints, plaster fixation. They will acquire the basic principles of diagnostic, investigative procedures, biochemical and diagnostic imaging and interpretation (a blood, urine, stool, ultrasound and X-ray evaluation findings). 2. Filling the practice of inpatient department: The aim of the activities of inpatient surgical work is to study all day inpatient care and patient management since its adoption until the release. This training is to deal with the administration of medical records (medical courses of disease records, scheduling and sending the examination consultative examination, discharge letters and insurance documentation), principles of laboratory and diagnostic imaging, patient preparation for surgery, the principles of post-operative care and the principles of postoperative and wound healing complications. 3. Filling practice in the operating room: The aim of the training in the operating room is to participate in the surgical procedures. The students will acquire the skills with the surgical techniques of classical and minimally invasive surgery. They improve the knowledge's about the surgical instruments, the synthesis of the tissue (suture and stapler), procedures for abdominal, thoracic, vascular and emergency surgery.
