5. Acute coronary syndrome. Unstable angina pectoris. Acute myocardial infarction with /without ST elevation. Acute treatment. Transport.
6. Pulmonary oedema cardiogenic, non-cardiogenic. Etiology, treatment.
7. Hypertensive crisis. Etiology. Consequences. Treatment.
